

PupSavers.org Spay/Neuter Agreement

PupSavers.org: Our mission is to find homes for as many unwanted puppies as possible and promote responsible pet ownership by requiring neutering or spaying of each puppy within 90 days of their adoption so no other animals will be born into unwanted situations every year.

The state of Colorado mandates rescue and shelter puppies must be altered within 90 days after adoption and rescues and shelters must collect a minimum \$50 spay/neuter deposit. Rescues and shelters must report to the state how many pups were adopted and that they were altered. PupSavers.org must have 100% compliance to this mandate.

The adopter is responsible to have the puppy altered within the 90-day timeframe and provide proof of spay/neuter to PupSavers.org rescue. This document or veterinarian's documentation must be returned to PupSavers.org as proof of compliance by **date**. When the rescue receives documentation within the required timeframe, the adopter's unopened deposit envelope will be returned.

If your veterinarian recommends that your pup is not ready to be altered within the 90-day timeframe set by state mandate, please email PupSavers pupsavers@gmail.com and request a **medical waiver** to still receive your deposit. Request the waiver by email or mail only, no phone calls please.

NOTICE FOR NONCOMPLIANCE: Failure to have adopted rescue puppy altered by 90 days of adoption and to provide proof to PupSavers.org has serious consequences. If adopter does not return documentation within the 90-day timeframe, the \$50 deposit is forfeited in accordance to the state mandate and donated to the rescue's choice of spay/neuter organization. PupSavers.org has the right to reclaim the puppy from the adopter's home and the adopter forfeits adoption fee, \$50 deposit and recourse. **SPAY/NEUTER BY DATE.**
